Mezzo-soprano Madelyn Wanner hails from New Holland, Pennsylvania. Ms. Wanner grew up playing the flute in the New Holland Band, and gained her first experiences as a vocal soloist with the group. She is a recent graduate of the Peabody Conservatory of Music of Johns Hopkins University. Operatic credits at Peabody include the role of Cherubino in Mozart's *Le nozze di Figaro*, The Child in Ravel's *L'Enfant et les sortilèges*, Second Lady in Mozart's *Die Zauberflöte*, and Hansel in Humperdinck's *Hansel and Gretel*. Ms. Wanner recently made her debut with the Baltimore Concert Opera singing Siebel in Gounod's *Faust*, and Hansel in *Hansel and Gretel*. Currently Ms. Wanner is pursuing graduate studies in the Maryland Opera Studio at the University of Maryland.
